**\*For multiple inquiries:** A separate Flood Determination Request Form will be needed for each property in question. The flood determination will be completed on or by the next business day after being received.

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We shall have a minimum of 8 hours to do our research and complete the form. Public reporting burden for this data collection is estimated to average 30 minutes per response. The burden estimate includes the time for reviewing instructions, searching existing data sources, gathering and maintaining the data needed and completing and submitting this form.

Federal law requires that a flood-insurance policy be obtained as a condition of a federally backed mortgage or loan that is secured by the building. It is up to the lender to determine whether insurance is required for a property. Flood insurance is available in Doña Ana County.

#### **NOTES:**

This information is based on the Flood Insurance Rate Map for Doña Ana County. This determination does not imply that the referenced property will or will not be free from flooding or damage. A property not in a Special Flood Hazard Area may be damaged by a flood greater than that predicted on the FIRM or from a local drainage problem not shown on the map. This determination does not create liability on the part of the County, the Flood Commission or any officer or employee thereof, for any damages that result from reliance on this information.

#### **\*DFIRM:**

The official FIRM is currently undergoing a revision and a countywide flood study is in progress, which may change the flood zone designation of the referenced property. The FIRM's are still in effect, this office cannot use the Preliminary Digital Flood Insurance Rate Map (DFIRM) to inform property owners of flood zone information. It is recommended that property owners periodically contact this office to check on the status of the DFIRM's.
