**RESOLUTION REGARDING PUBLIC INPUT AND AGENDA SETTING RULES
BEFORE THE EXTRA-TERRITORIAL ZONING AUTHORITY AND EXTRA-
TERRITORIAL ZONING COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, The Amended Joint City/County Extra-territorial Zoning and Subdivision Agreement entered into between the City of Las Cruces and Doña Ana County on February 3, 1997; and

WHEREAS, Section VIII, Organization and Meetings, of the Amended Joint City/County Extra-territorial Zoning and Subdivision Agreement, states “The Authority shall establish their own rules of order and procedures by resolution as they may find necessary and proper to carry out their work ” and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Extra-territorial Zoning Authority that the following public input and agenda setting rules shall apply in all hearings before the Authority and the Extra-territorial Zoning Commission:

- 1. RULES FOR PUBLIC INPUT DURING THE PUBLIC INPUT PORTION OF THE ETA and ETZ AGENDA**
 - A. A member of the Public may speak for three (3) minutes during the public input portion of the agenda, and the Chairperson may extend such time on a case-to-case basis if the Chairperson deems it warranted, or based on a motion approved by the majority of the Board.

- 2. AGENDA SETTING RULES**
 - A. During Authority or Commission Input, a member of the body may request an item, besides normal business, to be placed on the agenda of an upcoming meeting or the following regularly scheduled meeting and by a majority vote the membership may direct staff to hold a Work Session or schedule the item for action at a subsequent meeting.
