RESOLUTION NUMBER 2018-117

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE 2020 CENSUS

WHEREAS, the United States Census has been performed every ten years since 1790, with the last census in 2010; and

WHEREAS, the United States Government will be undertaking the Decennial Census in 2020; and

WHEREAS, April 1, 2020 is Census Day for the United States of America, Pursuant to Article I, Section 2 of the U.S. Constitution; and

WHEREAS, an accurate census is essential for the apportionment of representatives with the legislative bodies of the U.S. House of Representatives, the New Mexico State Legislature and within the County of Doña Ana voting districts; and

WHEREAS, correct apportionment of Federal dollars for health, education, transportation, child and elder care, emergency preparation and response, public and social support programs of all kinds depends on complete and accurate age, population, and other ethnic and demographic information gathered every ten years; and

WHEREAS, accurate census information is critical to planning for future growth, development and social needs of the County of Doña Ana; and

WHEREAS, the Census information is confidential and Federal law prohibits any public or private agency from gaining access to confidential Census data; and

WHEREAS, Doña Ana County contains members of population groups that are traditionally undercounted; and

WHEREAS, a number of unincorporated communities within Doña Ana County desire accurate information about the size and makeup of their respective communities; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Doña Ana County, State of New Mexico, hereby proclaims full support for and encourages all residents to participate in the 2020 U.S. Census; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners does hereby:

1. Acknowledge that County staff have already provided the U.S. Census Bureau with an updated residential list as part of the Local Update of Census Addresses (LUCA); and

2. Direct the County Manager to delineated and pursue expansion of Census Designated Places (CDP) identified in Doña Ana County through the Participant Statistical Areas Program (PSAP) as shown hereto on Exhibit "A"; and
3. Call for the formation and funding of a Census 2020 Complete Count Committee composed of key stakeholders within our communities, including elected officials, planners, community based organizations, business groups, religious institutions, and members of the media; and
4. Direct the County Manager to coordinate with the City of Las Cruces, Town of Mesilla, Village of Hatch, City of Anthony and the City of Sunland Park to organize a coordinated effort amongst the local governments throughout the County to ensure the most accurate outcome of Census 2020 and express support for cooperation with other Complete Count Committees within the region; and
5. Further direct the County Manager to promote greater community awareness and participation in the 2020 Census through public education initiatives in conjunction with local leadership and organizations from within government, the business community, the education sector, community and non-profit organizations, faith based groups, the media, youth and healthcare organizations; the intent of such collaboration being an increased response rate based on the unique knowledge and expertise of each organization.





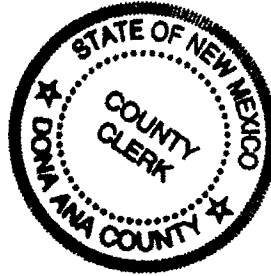
