

COUNTY EXTENDS DEADLINE FOR ADA ADVISORY COMMITTEE APPLICATIONS

Doña Ana County is seeking applications from residents interested in serving on the County’s Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Advisory Committee.

The advisory committee studies a broad range of issues related to ADA requirements and implementation and assists the county in identifying and setting priorities for compliance projects.

The advisory committee meets on a regular basis, currently during the work day, at the Doña Ana County Government Center, 845 N. Motel Blvd. in Las Cruces.

Residents are invited to apply who have significant disabilities included within the protections of the ADA; have experience in ADA compliance; or have a background or experience in disability and accessibility related matters who are not Doña Ana County officials or staff members.

The application deadline has been extended and applications will be accepted through 5 p.m., Friday, December 4, 2020. Applications can be downloaded from the county website, <https://donaanacounty.org/ada>.
